The cost for children will be \$75 each and they do need to be included on the registration form.

Location! Nestled in the scenic coastal redwoods of the Santa Cruz Mountains between San Francisco and Santa Cruz, *Redwood Glen* is the perfect place to find quiet space and enjoy the beauty of God's creation. And the central California coast and beaches are just a short drive down the mountains.



Situated on 165 acres and bordered by Pescadero Creek, Redwood Glen offers (for those with limited time and ability) short accessible trails that connect with more extensive trail systems for those who are looking for longer and more

challenging adventures. Redwood Glen shares borders with San Mateo Memorial Park and Pescadero Creek Park, and is connected with Portola State Park via Old Haul Road, with Big Basin State Park an ambitious but doable 9 miles for trail runners and well-seasoned day hikers.



The Siden Conference Center will be our home for the week. Surrounded by the beauty of the redwoods, it has hotel-style guest rooms, spacious meeting rooms, complimentary amenities, and restaurant quality food served buffet-style. Learn more about our retreat location at <u>redwoodglen.com</u>

Getting there: Redwood Glen is about a seven-hour drive from the Los Angeles area, and two to four hours from different locations in the Central Valley. For those flying in either SFO or San Jose airports will work, but you may find it easier from SFO. It is about an hour's drive from either airport. Their website has good directions for finding them, and you may lose cell service in the mountains on your way to the camp (we encourage you to print a map).
